What went well in this lesson? Why?	I believe I was successful in creating an environment where learners felt comfortable because they were able to discuss the themes and ideas from the texts.
What problems did I experience? Why?	I often found that some lessons ran over time, particularly during group discussions because I did not prepare appropriate time for that part of lesson.
Was it "learner-centered"? Should it have been?	Yes, learners were given the opportunity to find their own knowledge
What could I have done differently?	Spend less time explaining and give learners more time to work on the content
What did I learn from this experience that will help me in the future?	I will focus on improving my time management and ensuring that I provide sufficient support for learners.

Yes the assessment measures what I want but next time I need to find more ways to differentiate instruction, such as using simplified versions or more visuals, to make the content more accessible for all learners.

What went well in this lesson? Why?	I adopted a flipped classroom approach. Learners watch video lectures in advance of class, and during class they complete case studies that situate the content in real-life contexts
What problems did I experience? Why?	Learners commented on teaching evaluations that my assessment were too difficult. They complained that class made the material seem easy
Was it "learner-centered"? Should it have been?	Yes, learners were given the opportunity to find their own knowledge
What could I have done differently?	I think next time I must practice questions included clicker questions and questions for small- and large-group discussion.
What did I learn from this experience that will help me in the future?	I learned from this experience that learners appreciated the case studies. I realized how important it is to keep creating assessment questions based on the case
Preparation and research - Was I well prepared? - What could I have done differently?	Yes, I was well prepared and maybe I should change the way I introduce lessons by beginning every class period with a 10-15 minute introduction that shows students what they are supposed to learn

Presentation - Were the learners involved? Was I clear in my presentation? How was the pacing?	Yes learners we involved as I I asked them to specifically gather feedback about how to improve their engagement with case study learning.
